WHAT THE JOB INVOLVES:

Exterminators, under general supervision, perform work in the prevention, control, and elimination of insects, vermin and other pests from buildings and surrounding areas including parks; inspect areas of infestation; use the most effective insecticides, rodenticides, baits, traps, etc., for exterminating pests as required; keep records of equipment usage, work schedules, and exterminating operations performed; and may drive a motor vehicle. All Exterminators perform related work.

Special Working Conditions:

Exterminators may be required to work various shifts including nights, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.

Some of the physical activities performed by Exterminators and environmental conditions experienced are: walking to and from inspection sites during inspections, standing for an extended period of time, bending and stooping during inspections, working in confined areas, using bait and traps, and preparing insecticides and rodenticides for exterminating pests.

(This is a brief description of what you might do in this position and does not include all the duties of this position.)

THE SALARY:

The current minimum salary is \$37,182 per annum. This rate is subject to change. There are three assignment levels within this class of positions. Appointments will generally be made to Assignment Level I. After appointment, employees may be assigned to the higher assignment levels at the discretion of the agency.

HOW TO QUALIFY:

You are responsible for determining whether or not you meet the qualification requirements for this examination prior to submitting your application. If you are found "Not Qualified," your application fee will not be refunded and you will not receive a score.

Certification Requirement: By December 29, 2023 you must have:

A valid certificate as a **Certified Commercial Pesticide Applicator** for Industrial, Institutional, Structural and Rodent Control (7A) issued by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation.

This certification must be maintained for the duration of employment.

You have until midnight Eastern time on the last day of the Application Period (December 27, 2023) to clearly specify in detail all of your relevant certifications and experience and Final Submit your Education and Experience Exam in the Online Application System (OASys). Once you Final Submit your Education and Experience Exam in OASys, you will not be permitted to submit new or additional information on your Education and Experience Exam online.

If you do not Final Submit your Education and Experience Exam in OASys by midnight Eastern time on the last day of the Application Period (December 27, 2023), your examination will be considered incomplete, you will not receive a score, you will not be invited to subsequent portions of this examination (if applicable), and your application fee will not be refunded.

You will not receive credit for a certification which you obtain after December 29, 2023, or experience which you obtain after the end of the Application Period (December 27, 2023).

Residency Requirement Advisory: Under New York City Administrative Code Section 12-120, you might need to be a resident of the City of New York within 90 days of the date you are appointed to this position. Since residency requirements vary by title, appointing agency and length of service, consult the appointing agency's personnel office at the time of the appointment interview to find out if City residency is required.

English Requirement:

You must be able to understand and be understood in English.

Proof of Identity:

Under the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, you must be able to prove your identity and your right to obtain employment in the United States prior to employment with an agency under the jurisdiction of the Commissioner, Department of Citywide Administrative Services.

HOW TO APPLY:

If you believe you meet the requirements in the "How to Qualify" section, apply using the Online Application System (OASys) at *www.nyc.gov/examsforjobs*. Follow the onscreen application instructions for electronically submitting your application, payment, and completing any required information. A unique and valid email address is required to apply online. Several internet service providers, including but not limited to Google, Yahoo!, AOL, Outlook.com, and Mail.com offer free email addresses. All new OASys accounts require verification before a candidate can apply to ensure the accuracy of candidate information. Verification is instantaneous for most accounts and you will receive a confirmation email with instructions to activate your account. For any account creation issues, you will receive onscreen prompts to contact DCAS. This review may require up to two (2) business days to be reviewed and resolved. Please keep this information and the application period deadline in mind when creating your account.

The following methods of payment are acceptable: major credit card, bank card associated with a bank account, or a prepaid debit card with a credit card logo which you may purchase online or at various retail outlets. If you are receiving or participating in certain forms of public assistance/benefits/programs, or are a veteran, you may qualify to have the application fee waived. Effective January 2020, the Online Application System is no longer supported on Windows 7 or earlier versions of Windows operating systems.

You may come to the DCAS Computer-based Testing & Application Centers to apply for this examination online. However, you must schedule a customer service appointment prior to your visit. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, DCAS no longer permits walk-ins at DCAS sites.

If you do not Final Submit your Education and Experience Exam in OASys by midnight Eastern time on the last day of the Application Period (December 27, 2023), your examination will be considered incomplete, you will not receive a score, you will not be invited to subsequent portions of this examination (if applicable), and your application fee will not be refunded.

THE TEST:

Your score will be determined by an Education and Experience Exam. You will receive a score of 70 points for meeting the qualification requirements listed above. After these requirements are met, you will receive additional credit up to a maximum of 100 points on the following basis:

If you have satisfactory full-time experience performing the preparation, testing and application of pesticides after having obtained a valid certificate as a Certified Commercial Pesticide Applicator for Industrial, Institutional, Structural and Rodent Control (7A) for:

At least 6 months but less than 12 months At least 12 months but less than 18 months At least 18 months but less than 24 months At least 24 months but less than 30 months At least 30 months but less than 36 months At least 36 months but less than 42 months At least 42 months but less than 48 months At least 48 months but less than 54 months At least 54 months but less than 60 months At least 60 months but less than 66 months At least 66 months but less than 72 months 72 months or more

If you have a valid certificate as a:

Certified Commercial Pesticide Applicator for Industrial, Institutional, Structural and Public Health (8) issued by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation 5 points

Certified Commercial Pesticide Applicator (7B – Fumigation) issued by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation

During the Education and Experience Exam (EEE), you may answer questions about your experience. If your experience was on a part-time basis working less than 35 hours per week, you will need to convert your part-time experience to full-time experience using the formula below. Once you have determined your full-time experience equivalent, use this amount to answer questions about your experience.

(number of hours worked per week/35) x (number of months worked)

For example, if you worked at a job for 21 hours per week for 12 months, you would make the following calculation: $21/35 \times 12 = 7.2$ months.

You will receive a maximum of one year of experience credit for each year you worked. Experience must be obtained by December 27, 2023.

You have until midnight Eastern time on the last day of the Application Period (December 27, 2023) to clearly specify in detail all of your relevant certifications and experience and Final Submit your Education and Experience Exam in the Online Application System (OASys). Once you Final Submit your Education and Experience Exam in OASys, you will not be permitted to submit new or additional information on your Education and Experience Exam online.

If you do not Final Submit your Education and Experience Exam in OASys by midnight Eastern time on the last day of the Application Period (December 27, 2023), your examination will be considered incomplete, you will not receive a score, you will not be invited to subsequent portions of this examination (if applicable), and your application fee will not be refunded.

Certifications must be obtained by December 29, 2023. Experience must be obtained by the last day of the Application Period (December 27, 2023).

THE TEST RESULTS:

If you pass the Education and Experience Exam, your name will be placed in final score order on an eligible list, you will be given a list number and you will be notified by email of your test results. The eligible list determines the order by which candidates will be considered for appointment. If you meet all requirements and conditions, you will be considered for appointment if your name is reached on the eligible list. Once a list has been established, it will typically remain active for four years. If you believe that your test part was rated incorrectly, you may submit an appeal of your score to DCAS, Committee on Manifest Errors, through the Online Application System (OASys). Your appeal must give specific reasons why your score should be higher. Your appeal may result in a higher or lower rating.

- 6. Enter the details of your appeal by providing specific reasons why your score should be higher.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Selective Certification for Special Experience, Certifications or License: If you have the experience, certifications and/or license listed in one or more of the areas below, you may be considered for appointment to positions requiring this experience, certifications and/or license through a process called Selective Certification. If you qualify for Selective Certification, you may be given preferred consideration for positions requiring this experience, certifications and/or license. If you wish to apply for Selective Certification, follow the onscreen instructions when completing the Education and Experience Exam to indicate your interest in such Selective Certification and Final Submit it in the Online Application System (OASys). Your experience, certifications and/or license will be checked by the appointing agency at the time of appointment.

Selective Certification For Driver License (MVO): A motor vehicle Driver License that is valid in the State of New York. If you are appointed through Selective Certification, you must maintain your motor vehicle Driver License for the duration of your employment.

Selective Certification for Positions Requiring Certification as a Certified Commercial Pesticide Applicator For Industrial, Institutional, Structural and Food Processing (7F) issued by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (CPF): Possession of a valid Certified Commercial Pesticide Applicator For Industrial, Institutional, Structural and Food Processing (7F) certification issued by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation.

Selective Certification for the Department of Education which requires both Certification as a Certified Commercial Pesticide Applicator for Industrial, Institutional, Structural and Food Processing (7F) issued by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, and a Driver License (CPV): Possession of a valid Certified Commercial Pesticide Applicator for Industrial, Institutional, Structural and Food Processing (7F) certification issued by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and a motor vehicle driver license that is valid in the State of New York.

Selective Certification for Positions Requiring Experience Working in the Pest Control Program of the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (EPC): At least 6 (six) months of full-time satisfactory experience working in the Pest Control Program of the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.

The above Selective Certification requirements may be met at anytime during the duration of the list. You will be emailed a receipt immediately after you have applied for the examination. If you do not receive this receipt, check "Junk", "Trash", or "Spam" folders for the primary email linked to your Online Application System (OASys) account. If you are unable to locate the email, you can view a summary of the notification email to you on your OASys Dashboard, then Notifications. If you are still unable to find the email, please email DCAS via the Contact feature available in OASys with a description of the issue and include the exam number and your profile number located on your Profile page. While on your Profile page, check that the email addresses you provided are correct and/or updated.

This examination is for City Agencies only and not for the City University of New York ("CUNY") or the New York City Housing Authority (NYCHA). If you would like to apply for Exterminator (CUNY) you must submit a separate application and fee for Exam No. 4118 from December 7, 2023 through December 27, 2023. If you would like to apply for Housing Exterminator at NYCHA you must submit a separate application and fee for Exam No. 4051 from December 7, 2023 through December 27, 2023.

PENALTY FOR MISREPRESENTATION:

Any intentional misrepresentation on the application or examination may result in disqualification, even after appointment, and may result in criminal prosecution.
